

One-day on-site compliance assurance review

Red Kite Veterinary Consultants offers a one-day, on-site compliance assurance review designed as a light-touch “spot check” of A(SP)A 1986 compliance. The exact scope of the visit will be agreed in advance with the establishment’s senior management and may include facility tours, inspection of ongoing work, review of records, and/or interviews with key personnel such as scientists and animal technicians. The purpose is to provide a high-level assessment of operational practices and physical facilities, identifying potential risks of future non-compliance with ASPA requirements. The visit can be fully announced to staff or conducted as a “pseudo-unannounced” check, where only senior animal facility management is informed beforehand.

There is no intention that this service would provide a comprehensive assessment of all potential compliance risks. For this, one of our other services would be more appropriate.

Typical one-day on-site compliance assurance review:

- i. Agree scope of review in advance
- ii. One-day assessment visit (programme as agreed in step (i))
- iii. Close-out meeting (on-site) to present any initial, high-level findings.
- iv. Submission of post-visit report and recommendations¹
